### **Typical Timeline**

- Day 1: Banana harvest in Central America
- Day 3: Arrive at port in Central America
- Day 10: Ship arrives at port near San Diego
- Day 14: Truck arrives at Peirone in Spokane
- Day 19: 5 day ripening process completed
- Day 21: Bananas ship to your local store
- Day 22: Available for you to buy

## Many, Many Touch Points

#### **WORKERS INVOLVED**

- 1. Buyer: forecasts needs / places order
- 2. Farmer: plants & cultivates
- 3. Field worker: hand harvests
- 4. Field packer: grades, sorts, boxes
- 5. Truck driver: plantation to ports
- 6. Dock worker: loads on specialized boats
- 7. Boat crew: floats to California

#### **WORKERS INVOLVED**

- 8. Dock worker: unloads boat / loads truck
- 9. Truck driver: drives to Spokane
- 10. Peirone inspector: inspects for quality
- 11. Banana ripener: oversees 5 day process
- 12. Warehouse worker: assembles orders
- 13. Truck driver: drives to store
- 14. Produce clerk: available to consumers

# \$.69 Per Pound

A minimum wage person in Spokane would have to work for 2.9 minutes to earn enough to buy a pound of Bananas
