Fruit Update

- Apples Honeycrisp and Cosmic Crisp are still plentiful Organic Gala and Fuji will start to wind down next week.
- Cherries Cherry supplies are seeing an uptick with better weather in Central WA. Moving into better varieties like Skeenas and Corals
- Berries

 Strawberries and Blackberries are in good supply and quality. Raspberries are very tight and will continue to be for a few weeks. Local OR blues will be starting the end of this week
- Stone Fruit Apricot supply is starting to even out with good supplies on Organics and Conv. Local Peaches and Nectarines will start end of July with CA carrying the torch until then
- Grapes US grapes are in production with good volumes in both Red and Green grapes
- Citrus Valencia's are in full production in CA but the
 overall crop volume is down from last year, which is leading
 to tighter supplies. Navels are done until imports start end
 of July. Lemons are in CA now with smaller sizes being the
 peak. Limes will continue to be tough to come by but
 markets have steadied somewhat
- Melons Cants and Honeydew are showing lighter supplies. Expect WA melons to start at the end of July









- Mexico grapes have begun to diminish but CA will pick up the slack
- Gap in Blueberries as all picking in CA and other than NJ the east has finished, but OR and WA are just starting
- Strawberries in CA are hitting their peak this week and quality has improved

Veg Update

- Lettuce Moderate supplies with quality varying due to the heat. Pricing is steady
- Celery Oxnard growing area is close to being done and pricing will go up as supply goes down
- Broccoli & Cauli Good quality but light supplies have increased prices. CAN and Mexico will augment the crop
- Onions Lighter supplies out of CA leading to increased costs Walla Walla onions are looking good and local! Green Onions are promotable

Corn will continue to be an issue with the largest California grower not planting because of water. Expect local corn the last week in July.

- Potatoes Russets from WA, Red & Yellow from Cali until WA starts later this month. Russet quality and availability is suspect until new crop starts beginning of August.
- Peppers Pepper supplies are getting better and colored peppers add a nice color mix to your wet racks
- Artichokes
 – Sizing on Artichokes has been big with good supplies
- Organics The heat in California is affecting the organics just like the conventional. Supplies will remain tight.
- Corn Corn will continue to be a struggle with none out of CA because of water issues. Will need to use Eastern Corn.



VEG HARVEST HIGHTLIGHTS

- Artichokes sizing is peaking large
- Heat Wave is affecting many central CA Crops, quality and availability
- Water availability will continue to be an issue as the SW sees record setting drought conditions. Corn is being affected the most
