Re: Romaine Lettuce

Dear Customer,

We have recently been advised that the CDC has released a new statement regarding romaine lettuce and its potential for E.coli contamination. **“CDC is advising that U.S. consumers not eat any romaine lettuce, and retailers and restaurants not serve or sell any, until we learn more about the outbreak. This investigation is ongoing and the advice will be updated as more information is available”.**

At this time, the origin of the issue is unknown and none of our vendors are issuing formal recalls. However, out of an abundance of caution, we have decided to halt to shipping and distribution of any products containing whole or processed Romaine Lettuce.

We are not issuing a formal recall at this time but we will continue to work closely with our vendors and provide additional information as soon as it becomes available.
