CHERRIES STARTING TO BLOOM


Early Cherries in Patterson & Arvin Expected To Be In Full Bloom By Next Week

A positive sign is the uniformity of the blooms as they come out of the jackets, confirming a successful dormancy. These growing areas have the major early varieties including Corals, Brooks, Tulares, Royal Tiogas, and Royal Hazels.




