

## Dale's Latest Crop Update – June 2018

### Asparagus

- Washington and California volumes remain steady, look for both regions to go till the beginning of July. Michigan's supplies continue to increase next week heading for peak production the first week of June
- Mexico's production will transition from Ciudad Obregon (which is now finished for the season) to Guanajuato, Guanajuato is into light production this week but will see increasing volume over the next few weeks

### Corn

- California and Texas supplies will remain good, California will start to transition in another 2 weeks from the Imperial Valley to the west side (Mendota, CA)
- Market prices will ease downward for the expected decline in demand post-holiday and providing weather cooperates in the east

### Cucumbers

- No change in the west for imports from Mexico, supplies are good from Baja and continue to decline from Nogales
- Market prices steady from the east and steady to higher from the west

### Green Bells

- Coachella CA supplies stay low due to prior weather's effect on fruit sizing and its season drawing to a close, California production will transition to Bakersfield and coastal areas when Coachella finishes
- Market prices will be steady from both the east and the west
